**WHEREAS,** for more than a decade the Board of Education and the Little League have entered into various Lease Agreements whereby the Little League was permitted to install field lights and to utilize the Fields when they were not needed for school purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Little League also undertook certain maintenance and insurance obligations as a condition of the use of the Fields;

**NOW THEREFOR BE IT RESOLVED, RESOLVED**, that the Green Brook Board of Education hereby authorizes the Lease Agreement with the Green Brook Little League, Inc., for the period January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014 with the option to renew for three additional one year periods which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference for an amount of One Dollar (\$1.00) per year and other valuable consideration; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the Board hereby determines that the Fields are not necessary for school purposes for the dates and times requested by the Little League as provided by the terms of the Lease Agreement and subject to Board Policy governing the annual use of school facilities; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the Board President is hereby authorized to execute the Lease Agreement between the parties.
