Dear Parents/Guardians of Eighth Grade Students:

Although it may seem strange to be discussing graduation this early in the year, we are already planning for this special eighth-grade event.

All students in the graduating class of 2018, (current eighth graders) will be wearing caps and gowns for graduation in June. Caps and gowns are worn for a number of reasons:
